Pastor's Lucid Ramblings

"The Church Militant"

1 Timothy 6:12 Fight the good fight for the Christian faith.

I am a proud American veteran. Therefore, when the cranberry hymnal (ELW) was introduced in 2006, I was disappointed to hear that "church militant" hymns were removed. It wasn't just because old favorites like, "Stand Up, Stand Up for Jesus" (LBW #389) and "Onward Christian Soldiers" (LBW #509) weren't in the new hymnal; it was because synod leadership actually believed that these hymns were too "military" sounding. (I can't make this stuff up!)

Listen to some of the words of "Onward Christian Soldiers" "Onward Christian Soldiers, marching as to war, With the cross of Jesus, going on before."

Brothers and sister, we are in a spiritual war. The powers of Satan have convinced many in the Church that we should be passive and allow sin to take place. This isn't anything new. When Paul wrote his letters to Timothy because of issues with the fledgling church in Ephesus, false teachers and teachings, polygamy, and various forms of Gnosticism were already being introduced into the Church. We cannot stand for this!

The old saying, "When the going gets tough, the tough get going!" applies here. While a spiritual war is in full force, God gives us everything we need. Ephesians 6:11, "Put on all the armor that God supplies. In this way you can take a stand against the devil's strategies." God promises to not leave us to fight this battle alone. We have direct access to His power through prayer and He promises to not leave us nor forsake us. (Deuteronomy 31:6)

Now is not the time to sit back and let someone fight for the Gospel. Now is the time to:

Stand up, stand up for Jesus, As soldiers of the cross, Lift high his royal banner; It must not suffer loss. From victory unto victory, His army he shall lead, Till every foe is vanquished and Christ is Lord indeed.
